**5 YEAR BURN PERMIT
FOR BURN BARREL AND 3' X 2' BURN PILE**

Call the Burn Information Recording at **541-996-1008** for current burn conditions.

Requirements:

- A water source and hand tools must be readily available on scene at time of burn.
- Burn piles are not to exceed **3' in diameter and 2' high** and must be at least **25 feet** from any structure. Burn barrels must be **15 feet** from any structure.
- For backyard burning, there must be a **10-foot firebreak** around the burn pile or burn barrel.
- Smoke must be kept to an ABSOLUTE MINIMUM.
- Do not burn under low overhanging trees.
- Do not burn if winds exceed 15 miles per hour.
- Do not burn before sunup or after sundown.
- FIRE MUST BE CONSTANTLY ATTENDED UNTIL IT IS COMPLETELY OUT!

Things to keep in mind:

- Be considerate of your neighbors. Smoke will not be allowed to intrude into or around any structures. If complaints are received because of smoke, you will be required to extinguish the fire or otherwise control the smoke.
- Permits may be revoked for violations of these rules or Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) regulations, and may result in a civil penalty levied by the DEQ.
- Burning will not be allowed when the weather or other conditions may cause an unsafe environment. The Fire Chief, at his discretion, can impose more stringent conditions or may waive certain requirements depending on prevailing conditions.
- Burning of waste from commercial establishments, construction, and demolition activities is prohibited in the Fire District. Also prohibited is the burning of garbage, paper, plastics, rubber, petroleum products, auto parts, asphalt, wire insulation, or any other non-organic materials. Yard debris to be burned must be from the property listed above.

In accordance with provisions of ORS 478.960, 478.965, and 476.380, a permit is hereby issued.
