 Requirements: A water source and hand tools must be readily availage. Burn piles are not to exceed 3' in diameter and 2' his barrels must be 15 feet from any structure. For backyard burning, there must be a 10-foot firebrest smoke must be kept to an ABSQLUTE MINIMUM. Do not burn under low overhanging trees. Do not burn if winds exceed 15 miles per hour. Do not burn before sunup or after sundown. FIRE MUST BE CONSTANTLY ATTENDED UNTIL I 	igh and must be at least 25 feet from any structure. Burn reak around the burn pile or burn barrel.
 Permits may be revoked for violations of these rules of and may result in a civil penalty levied by the DEQ. Burning will not be allowed when the weather or othe Chief, at his discretion, can impose more stringent coprevailing conditions. Burning of waste from commercial establishments, conditions. District. Also prohibited is the burning of garbage, par 	allowed to intrude into or around any structures.
